

## Abies balsamea 'Eugene's Yellow' Eugene's Yellow Balsam Fir

## **Plant Description**

A dwarf spreading evergreen conifer with light yellow needles. Prefers AM sun/PM shade in well-drained soil. 1' tall x 1.5' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -40 degrees. USDA zone 3.



# **Abies concolor 'Blue Cloak'**Blue Cloak White Fir

#### **Plant Description**

A dense, semi-pendulous conifer with thin, soft-blue needles. Forms its strong, upward leader surrounded by softly-weeping branches. Prefers sun in well-drained soil. 7' tall  $\times$  4' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -40 degrees. USDA zone 3.



# Abies koreana 'Ice Breaker'

#### **Ice Breaker Korean Fir**

## **Plant Description**

A miniature evergreen conifer with a spreading habit. Dense foliage is silvery-blue due to the undersides of recurved needles. Originated as a witch's broom from 'Silberlocke' in Germany. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 8" tall x 12" wide 10 years. Hardy to -30 degrees. USDA zone 4



## Abies koreana 'Tundra'

## Tundra Korean Fir

## **Plant Description**

A miniature spreading evergreen conifer with green needles. A rock garden gem. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 1' tall x 2' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -30 degrees. USDA zone 4



# Abies nordmanniana 'Golden Spreader' Golden Spreader Caucasian Fir

## **Plant Description**

A dwarf, spreading conifer. Rich, bright yellow needles in sun, soft yellow-green if in shade. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 1' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -30 degrees. USDA zone 4.



# Acer palmatum 'Amber Ghost' Amber Ghost Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

An upright deciduous tree. Spring leaves emerge with pink and amber hues and darkly-contrasting veins (reticulation). Summer brings on increasingly-deeper amber tones until fall when fiery reds and golds take over. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 10' tall x 8' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Acer palmatum 'Ariadne' Ariadne Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

An upright, broad deciduous tree. New growth appears in pastel shades of light orange, pink and red which contrasts brilliantly with lime-green veins. Fall colors include bright hues of orange, pink, and red once more. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 7' tall x 5' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Acer palmatum 'Coral Pink' Coral Pink Japanese Maple

### **Plant Description**

An upright deciduous tree with a dense bushy form. Small leaves are a white-green color with light pink new growth. This outstanding new maple is perfect for a container or in a small garden. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 6' tall x 4' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -10 degrees. USDA zone 6.



# **Acer palmatum 'Fairy Hair'** Fairy Hair Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

A slow-growing, dwarf deciduous tree. Extremely narrow and long, almost hair-like, green leaves in summer. Fall color: orange. Fascinating as it is popular. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 2' tall x 1' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



Acer palmatum 'Geisha Gone Wild' Geisha Gone Wild Japanese Maple

A spectacular new maple. This small deciduous tree has leaves with purple-pink, white and green coloration. Fall color is purple-orange. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 6' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -10 degrees. USDA zone 6.



# Acer palmatum 'Hana matoi' Hana matoi Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

A deciduous tree with a dwarf mounding form. Finely dissected green leaves are streaked with white, pink and red--a fantastic color show. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 2' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



Acer palmatum 'Ilarian' Ilarian Japanese Maple

A small, deciduous upright tree with tiny green leaves with dazzling pink and white variegation. Fall color is orange. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 8' tall x 4' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -10 degrees. USDA zone 6.



Acer palmatum 'Koto no ito' Koto no ito Japanese Maple

A dense, deciduous, upright shrub with crimson tones on narrow-lobed green leaves and bright green bark in spring. Fall color in various shades of vivid yellow. Name means "harp strings" in Japanese. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 6' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Acer palmatum 'Mayday' Mayday Japanese Maple

## **Plant Description**

A dwarf deciduous shrub with an irregular form and short internodes. Spring foliage is pinkish white, turning blonde-green by summer. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 3' tall by 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Acer palmatum 'Mikazuki' Mikazuki Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

Bushy, upright deciduous form having narrow-lobed leaves with lovely pink blush over white with green reticulation. Color holds well through summer. Name means "crescent moon" in Japanese. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 8' tall x 5' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5. Discovered and introduced by the Flora Wonder(tm) Collection of Buchholz Nursery.



# Acer palmatum 'Orange Dream' Orange Dream Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**


A bushy, upright deciduous tree. In spring foliage emerges yellow with bright orange margins and tips, turning yellow-green midsummer. Fall color is bright gold. Prefers AM sun/PM shade in well-drained soil. 8' tall x 5' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -10 degrees. USDA zone 6.



# Acer palmatum 'Peve Multicolor' Peve Multicolor Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

A dwarf deciduous tree with thin branches and a bushy upright form. Small thin leaves have five serrated and pointed lobes. Foliage is green frosted with pink and white. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 5' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Acer palmatum 'Purple Ghost' Purple Ghost Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

A medium-size, upright deciduous tree. Spring leaves are deep purple-red with prominent black veins, then turn fiery-red to orange in fall. One of the very best selections in recent years. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 8' tall x 4' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Acer palmatum 'Wakehurst Pink' Wakehurst Pink Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

A broad upright deciduous tree with bronze-green leaves with pinkish variegation. Discovered at the famous Wakehurst Garden in England. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 8' tall x 5' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Acer shirasawanum 'Jordan' Jordan Full Moon Maple

## **Plant Description**


An upright deciduous tree with a full bushy form. Leaves are bright yellow (to yellow-green if grown in shade). Will not burn in most climates. A recent introduction from Italy. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 8' tall x 4' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Acer japonicum 'Aconitifolium' Aconitifolium Japanese Maple

#### **Plant Description**

A round, spreading deciduous tree with large medium-green leaves in summer. Fall color is in fiery shades of red and orange--one of the best displays one can ask for. Also known as the "dancing-peacock" or "fernleaf" Maple. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 8' tall x 6' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Fagus sylvatica 'Ansorgei'

## Ansorgei European Beech

## **Plant Description**

A small, upright deciduous tree with long, narrow dark purple leaves. This willowy form was selected by Ansorge in Germany over 100 years ago. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 6' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -30 degrees. USDA zone 4.




Ginkgo biloba 'Mariken' Mariken Maidenhair Tree

This slow-growing, deciduous dwarf has small, rich green leaves. Vivid gold hues enhance its diminutive form in fall. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 1' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -30 degrees. USDA zone 4.

# Larix decidua 'Puli' Puli European Larch

### **Plant Description**

This new conifer grows as a very low groundcover, or it can be staked into a narrow weeping tree. The name "puli" is derived from a Hungarian breed of dog which has curly hair that drops straight down. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 6" tall  $\times$  3' wide in 10 years, if unstaked. 8' tall  $\times$  1-2' wide if staked. Hardy to -50 degrees. USDA zone 2



# Picea abies 'Acro-yellow' Acro-yellow Norway Spruce

#### **Plant Description**

A dwarf evergreen conifer with an irregular upright form. Needles are frosted with butter-yellow. Numerous ornamental cones are featured. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 5' tall  $\times$  3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -50 degrees. USDA zone 2.



Picea abies 'Gold Drift'
Gold Drift Norway Spruce

A dwarf evergreen conifer with a weeping form. Can be grown as a groundcover or staked into a small weeping tree. Needles are butter-yellow. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. If staked, 6' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -50 degrees. USDA zone 2.



Picea abies 'Perry's Gold' Perry's Gold Norway Spruce

A fantastic dwarf evergreen conifer with short green needles. In spring new growth is butter yellow. 'Perry's Golden' positively glows in the spring garden. Prefers AM sun/PM shade in well-drained soil. 4' tall x 2' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -50 degrees. USDA zone 2.



# Picea breweriana 'Fruhlingsgold' Spring Gold Brewer's Weeping Spruce

#### **Plant Description**

A slow-growing evergreen conifer with a broadly-pyramidal form. Branchlets droop downward, giving a weeping appearance. New growth in spring is light gold. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 5' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5



Picea engelmannii 'Snake' Snake Engelmann Spruce

A curious upright evergreen conifer with whip-cord branching. No two trees look alike. Needles are a dark blue-green. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 7' tall x 2' wide in 10 years. Hardy to 60 degrees. USDA zone 1.



Picea glauca 'Ketch Harbor' Ketch Harbor White Spruce

An upright evergreen conifer with deep blue-green needles. Branches arch downward gracefully. Discovered in the wild in Nova Scotia. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. If staked, 6' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -60 degrees. USDA zone 1.



Picea omorika 'Berliner's Weeper' Berliner's Weeping Serbian Spruce

An upright evergreen conifer with drooping side branches. The entire form is narrow, making it useful for small landscapes. Foliage is deep green. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 7' tall x 2.5' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -40 degrees. USDA zone 3.



# Picea omorika 'Bruns' Bruns Serbian Spruce

## **Plant Description**

A dense, compact evergreen conifer with dark green needles. Form is narrowly pyramidal. From the Bruns Nursery in Germany. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 5' tall x 2' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -40 degrees. USDA zone 3.

## Picea pungens 'Maigold' May Gold Colorado Spruce

#### **Plant Description**

An upright evergreen confier with a dense pyramidal form. New growth in spring is bright yellow-gold which contrasts with the older gray blue-green needles. An outstanding selection from Germany. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 7' tall x 4' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -40 degrees. USDA zone 3.



Pinus koraiensis 'Morris Blue' Morris Blue Korean Pine

A slow-growing evergreen conifer with silver blue-green foliage. No one can resist touching the needles of a Korean Pine. Originated from the Morris Arboretum of Pennsylvania. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 6' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -40 degrees. USDA zone 3.



Pinus mugo 'Carsten's Winter Gold' Carsten's Winter Gold Mugo Pine

A dwarf spreading evergreen conifer. Short needles are light green in spring and summer, then turn to rich gold in winter. Cold climates will notice more intense color. Easily one of the best of all winter-gold pines. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 1.5' tall x 2' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -50 degrees. USDA zone 2.

## Pinus parviflora 'Tanima no yuki' Tanima no yuki Japanese White Pine

#### **Plant Description**

A slow-growing evergreen conifer with a globose form. Needles are mostly white, or white at the tip of the blue-green needles. The name means "snow in the valley" in Japanese. Prefers sun/partial shade in well-drained soil. 18" tall x 18" wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



Pinus parviflora 'Tansu kazu' Tansu kazu Japanese White Pine

A slow-growing evergreen conifer with a low spreading form. Dark blue-green needles are variegated in gold, in fact the plant looks entirely gold from a distance. Prefers AM sun/PM shade in well-drained soil. 1' tall x 2' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -20 degrees. USDA zone 5.



# Pinus strobus 'Diggy' Diggy Eastern White Pine

## **Plant Description**

A dwarf evergreen conifer with a compact form. Short, thin green needles have a twist. A great addition for the small landscape as 'Diggy' never outgrows its place. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 3' tall x 1.5' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -40 degrees. USDA zone 3.



# Pinus strobus 'Tiny Kurls' Tiny Kurls Eastern White Pine


## **Plant Description**

A dwarf evergreen conifer with a dense flat-globe form. Dark blue-green needles are twisted. More interesting than most of the numerous dwarf pines. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 2' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -40 degrees. USDA zone 3.



Pinus sylvestris 'Gold Medal' Gold Medal Scot's Pine

A slow-growing upright evergreen conifer with rich golden needles. Color is most intense in winter, but it is still rather gold in summer as well. Prefers full sun in well-drained soil. 5' tall x 3' wide in 10 years. Hardy to -50 degrees. USDA zone 2.
