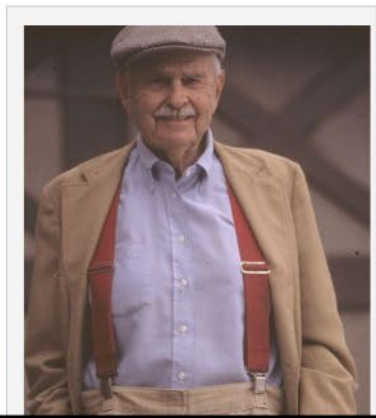



# Picea abies 'Pendula' / weeping Norway spruce

*Picea abies* 'Pendula' is used as a collective term that describes the myriad weeping and pendulous forms of Norway spruce that exist in the international nursery trade. Such plants have been well-known and popular throughout history and no individual clone can be identified as the origin of them all. At some point taxonomists will formally assign these trees under a "form-status," i.e. *Picea abies* forma *pendula*. However this has not yet happened. Below are notes from growers

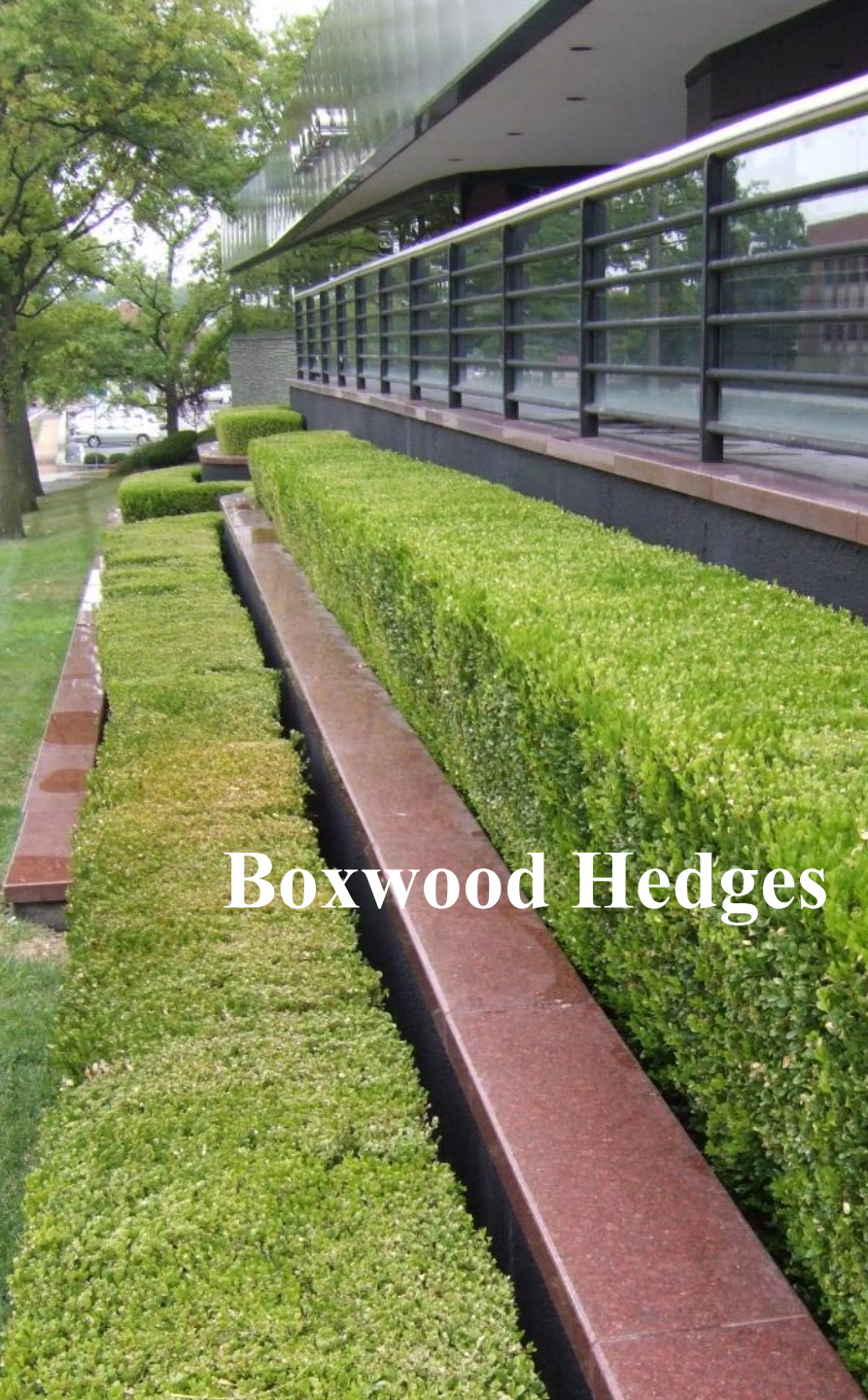

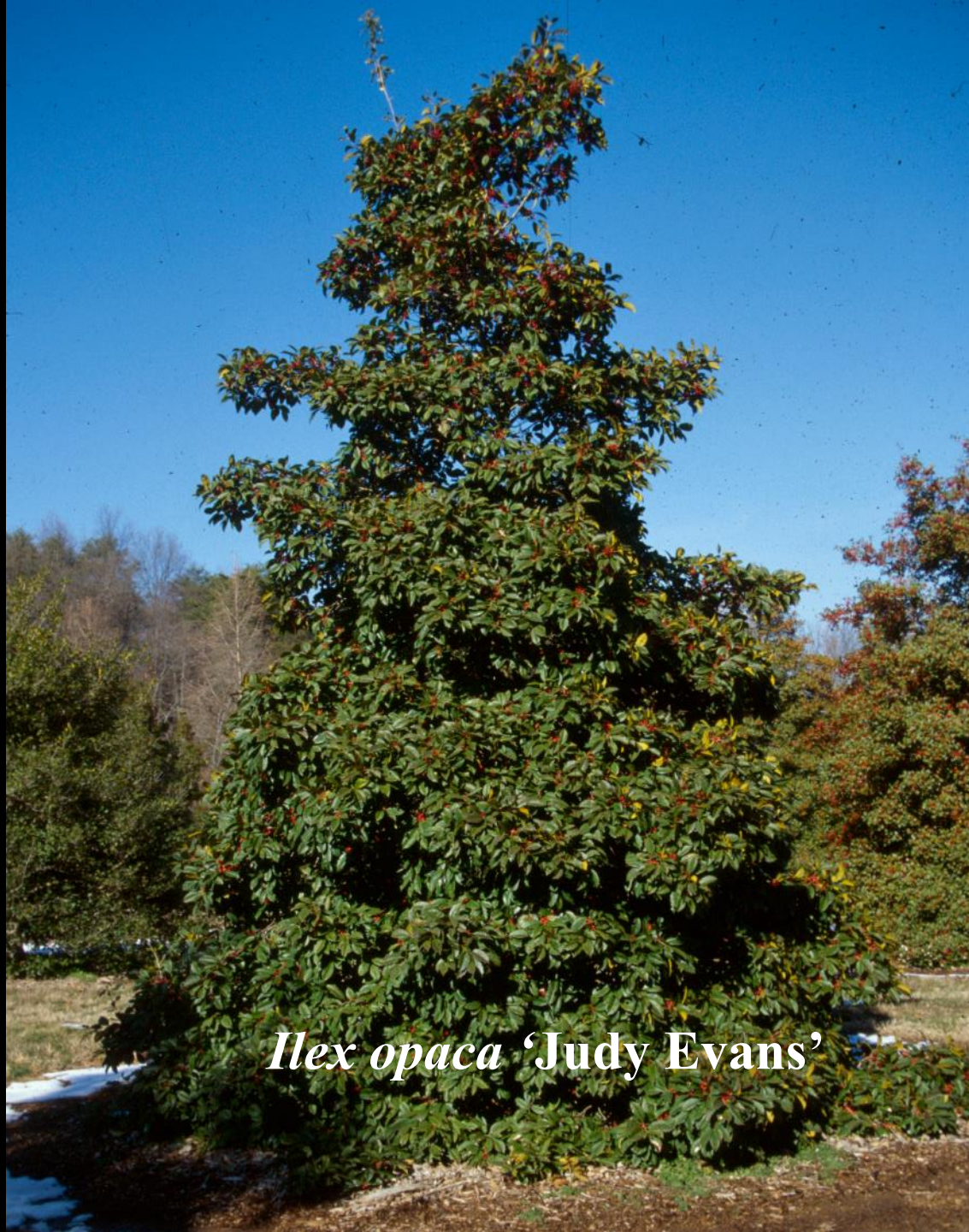

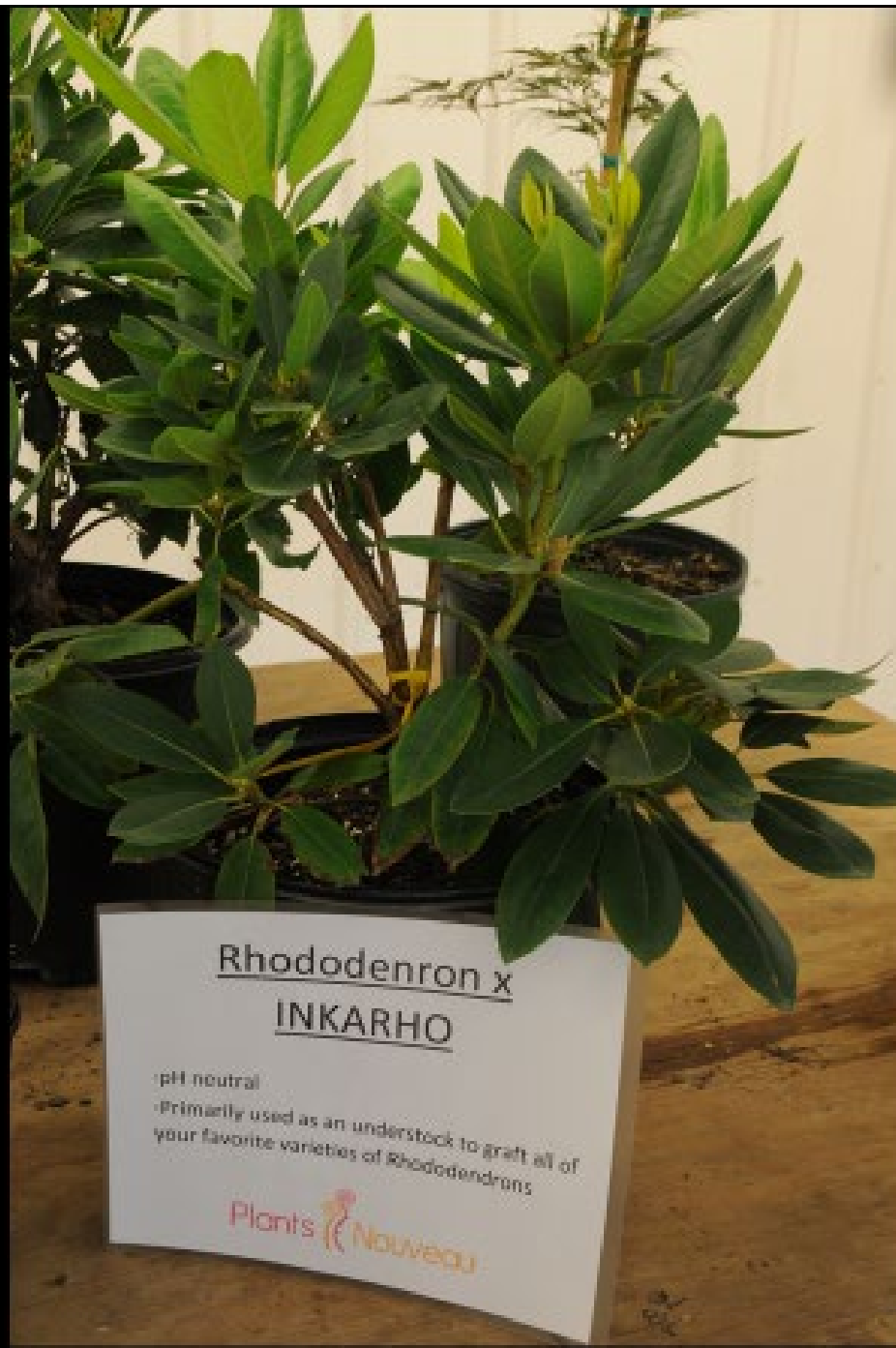
