

Safety

Please immediately pull out the AC power plug from adapter if there is an abnormal sound or smell or the LED TV has sound but no picture, and contact after sales support.



The LED TV should be kept free from rain, damp and dust to prevent electrical shock and short circuits. Do not cover the ventilation openings with table clothes, curtains, newspapers etc.





The LED TV should be kept from high temperature heating objects or direct sunlight. It requires good ventilation. Allow 10cm between the LED TV and

other appliances or built-in cabinet walls.

You may clean the display panel with a soft clean cloth after pulling out the power plug. Do not repeatedly wipe the panel, nor scrape, tap or strike the panel with a hard object.

Do not wipe the LED TV with any petrol, chemical or alcohol based solvents as it will lead to product damage of the panel and cabinet.

Do not disassemble the back cover as it contains high voltages inside and will cause electric shock. Internal adjustments and checks should only be conducted by qualified professionals.

Do not place naked flame sources, such as lit candles on or near the LED TV. Please pull out the power plug and contact after sales support if there are abnormal objects or water in the TV.





Pull out the power cord and antenna cable during electrical storms so the LED TV is not damaged by electrical surges. Keep all people away from the antenna cable during electrical storms.

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Installation

Thank you very much for your purchase of this product. Please read this manual carefully and keep it safe for reference.

Please use the power cord designated for the product. When an extension cord is required, use one with the correct power rating. The cord must be grounded. The product should be installed on a flat surface to avoid tipping. Space should be maintained between the back of the product and the wall for proper ventilation. If you would like to mount the TV to the wall, please see "Preparing the LED for Wall Mounting" below for additional information. Avoid installing the product in the kitchen, bathroom or other places with high humidity.

Preparing Your LED TV For Wall Mounting

The HDTV can either be kept on the stand or mounted to the wall for viewing. If you choose to mount the HDTV to the wall, please follow the instructions below .

Unplug all the cables and cords from your LED TV.

Place the LED TV face down on a soft and flat surface (blanket, foam, cloth, etc) to prevent any damage to the display.

Remove the stand screws allowing the stand to be removed.

The mounting bracket is made up of two parts - the wall bracket and the TV bracket. Attach the TV bracket to the TV via the included screws. included with your wall mount kit (Please check the instruction manual of the wall mount for further information) Attach the wall bracket to the wall with appropriate screws. Ensure the wall is suitable to hold the weight of the TV. (Please check the instruction manual of the wall mount for further information)

Slide the TV bracket into the wall bracket. Ensure the wall mount is secured and locked in travel position when the RV is in transit

Important Notes

RESET: Like any product controlled by microprocessors this TV may hang or become unresponsive, in the unlikely event this occurs simple disconnect the power and reconnect after 10 seconds.

REMOTE: To prevent leakage which may result in bodily harm or damage to the remote: 1. Install AAA batteries correctly, and make sure polarities are correctly aligned with the battery compartment markings.

Do not mix batteries (OLD and NEW or CARBON and ALKALINE ,etc)
 Remove batteries when the remote is not used for a long time.

My music, movie or image files do not display? Due to the large variation of file sizes, compression formats and codec available, playback of all files cannot be guaranteed.

I cannot record onto my USB flash drive? FAT 32 formatted flash drive is required.

Time Shift functionality does not work? FAT 32 formatted flash drive is required.

Warning! Do not keep images on the screen for a long time

To prevent the screen from burn in, do not leave static images including menu screens displayed for a period of time. Burn in is not covered under warranty provision.

ATTENTION: Do not try to update the TV unless directed by a service technician. Product misconfigured by an incorrect update is not covered under warranty.

Connections

Bottom Connection Panel:



Power:

Connect the AC power pack or 3M 12V RV lead to the **12V DC IN** connection on the TV.

HDMI3/HDMI2/HDMI1

Connect the HDMI output of the accessory device to the HDMI input on the TV. Select the HDMI input source using the INPUT button on the remote. The ARC function is available when select HDMI2.

Y/Pb/Pr In:

Component input terminal

VGA/PC Audio In:

Connect the **RGB** output of the PC to the **VGA** input on the TV. Connect the PC audio output of the PC to the **Audio** input jack on the TV Select the **VGA** input source usine the **INPUT** button on the remote.

NOTE:

Do not put the Coaxial cable close to the mains lead to avoid noise. Do not place the Coaxial cable under the TV. Additional equipment, cables and adapter plugs shown are not supplied with this TV set. To obtain optimum quality picture and sound, an Aerial, the correct cable (75 Ω coaxial) and the correct terminating plug are required. Your local dealer may be able to assist you in obtaining the correct Aerial system for your particular area and the accessories required.

CEC:

There are two selections: "ON" and "OFF", when you choose "ON", you can operate a compatible HDMI-CEC controlled device.

Amplifier Support ARC:

There are two selections: "ON" or "OFF", it is available when the "Speaker Preference" is set to "Amplifier". When selected to "ON", sound from Amplifier will be heard, when selecting "OFF", no sound from the amplifier will be heard.

Connect the antenna to the **RFIN** connection. Please refer to the Antenna Connection paragraph below.

USB

Insert the **USB** flash drive into the **USB** slot on the TV. Select the **USB** input source using the **MEDIA** or **INPUT** button on the remote.

Video/Audio In:

Connect the **VIDEO** and **AUDIO** output jack of the DVD or VCR to the **VIDEO/L/R IN** jacks using an AV cable (Yellow [Video], White and Red [left and right audio]). Select the AV input source using the **INPUT** button on the remote.

Earphone Out: Audio output for external devices.

Press the **MUTE** button to mute the audio. (Note: This will not mute the line-level audio output).

The HDTV will indicate that it is in a mute state.

Press the MUTE button to un-mute the audio.

Display

Press the **DISPLAY** button to preview the curent program number, current input mode, or any relevent source information.

Press the DISPLAY button again to remove this information.

Power

To operate the HDTV: Ensure you have connected the HDTV correctly and that power is supplied to the TV. A **RED** LED indicates Standby Mode. A **GREEN** LED indicates the HDTV is ON.

Press the ${\rm POWER}$ button to power ON the television. The front LED will change from ${\rm RED}$ to ${\rm GREEN}$ to indicate that that HDTV has been turned ON.

Press the **POWER** button to power OFF the television. The front LED will change from **GREEN** to **RED** to indicate that that HDTV has been turned OFF.

Channel +/-

Press the + button to change the channel/chapter up. Press the - button to change the channel/chapter down.

Numeric Keypad

To directly select a channel or chapter number:

Press the required number from 0-9 on the keypad. It will directly change to the choosen channel/chapter.

To select a 2-digit channel/chapter number, press the -/-- button followed by the numbers you desire.



NOTE:

• AUTO TUNE Button allows for a Quick and Easy retuning method when travelling. Re-Tuning is required for each and every time you change locations in your RV. 1. Aim the AUX RCU at the Sphere RCU at 3-5cm apart

- PRESS & HOLD LEARN button on Sphere RCU for 5 Seconds
 On the Sphere RCU PRESS the learning button you wish to program
- Then press the button on the AUX RCU that you wish to control

These openings should never be blocked by placing the unit on a bed, sofa, rug, or other similar surface. This unit should never be placed near or over a radiator or heat source. This unit should not be placed in a built-in installation, such as a bookcase, or rack unless proper ventilation is provided or the manufacture's instructions have been observed to.

10. POWER SOURCE - This unit should be operated only from the type of power source indicated on the rating plate. If you are not sure of the type of power supply to your home, consult your appliance dealer or local power company. For units intended to operate from battery power, or other sources, refer to the operating instructions.

11. POLARIZATION - This unit is equipped with a polarized alternating current line plug (a plug having one blade wider than the other). This plug will fit into the power outlet only one way. This is a safety feature. If you are unable to insert the plug fully into the outlet, try reversing the plug. If the plug still fails to fit, contact your electrician to replace your obsolete outlet. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized plug.

12. POWER-CORD PROTECTION - Power supply cords should be routed so that they are not likely to be walked on or pinched by items placed upon or against them, paying particular attention to cords at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the appliance.

13. LIGHTNING - To protect your unit during a lightning storm, or when it is left unattended and unused for long periods of time, unplug it from the wall outlet and disconnect the antenna or cable system. This will prevent damage to the unit due to lightning and power line surges.

14. POWER LINES - An outside antenna system should not be located in the vicinity of overhead power lines, or other electric light or power circuits, or where it can fall into such power lines or circuits. When installing an outside antenna system, extreme care should be taken to keep from touching such power lines or circuits as contact with them might be fatal.

15. OVERLOADING - Do not overload wall outlets and extension cords as this can result in a risk of fire or electric shock

or electric SHOCI

16. OBJECT AND LIQUE DNTRY - Do not push objects through any openings in this unit as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short out parts that could result in fire or electric shock. Never spill or spray any type of liquid into the unit. The lightning flash with arrowhead symbol, within an equilateral triangle, is intended to alert the user to the presence of uninsulated "dangerous voltage" within the product's enclosure that may be of sufficient magnitude to constitute a risk of electric shock to persons.

The exclamation point within an equilateral triangle is intended to alert the user to the presence of important operating and maintenance (servicing) instructions in the literature accompanying the appliance.

1 7 SERVICING - Do not attempt to service this unit yourself as opening or removing covers may expose you to dangerous voltage or other hazards. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

- 18.DAMAGE REQUIRING SERVICE Unplug this unit from the wall outlet and refer servicing to qualified service personnel under the following conditions:
- A. When the power-supply cord or plug is damaged.
- B. If liquid has been spilled, or objects have fallen into the unit.
- If the unit has been exposed to rain or water.
- D. If the unit does not operate normally by following the operating instructions. Adjust only those controls that are covered by the operating instructions, as an improper adjustment of other controls may result in damage and will often require extensive work by a qualified technican to restore the unit to Its normal operation.
- E. If the unit has been dropped or the cabinet has been damaged.
- E When the unit exhibits a distinct change in performance, this indicates a need for service.

19. REPLACEMENT PARTS - When replacement parts are required, be sure the service technician uses replacement parts specified by the manufacturer or those that have the same characteristics as the original part. Unauthorized substitutions may result in fire, electric shock or other hazards.

20. SAFETY CHECK - Upon completion of any service or repairs to this unit, ask the service technician to perform safety checks to determine that the unit is in proper operating condition.

21. HEAT - The product should be situated away from heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other products (including amplifiers) that produce heat.

WARNING: Do not leave any stationary images, patterns, PIP box, or letterbox images on the screen for an extended period of time. Also, do not display the same stationary patterns frequently. This may result in permanent ghost times on the display unit. This yee of damage is not covered under warranty.
